Application **Procedures**

Visa Requirement	Students should apply for their Uzbekistan VISA at the Uzbekistan Embassy or Consulate in the home country. Exchange students are required to obtain a A1 Visa.		
Accommodation	Exchange students are guaranteed on-campus dormitory at their own expense and payment is made in cash upon arrival. Fee: Twin room: about 30\$ /person/month Triple room: about 30\$ /person/month
