Let me once again express my deep satisfaction with the level of our cooperation in the framework of the Erasmus + Technology in Rehabilitation project and confirm our readiness to fulfill the TUIT's obligations on this project. I am pleased to inform you that our university has decided to admit 3 students to Master's courses of the Department "Computer Systems" in the specialization "Computer Systems in Medicine" from September 1, 2018.

Unfortunately, the delay in the trip of our teachers and students to Italy and France for the refresher courses (scheduled for the end of August and the beginning of September) didn't allow us to fully implement our plans to open a master's program for 6-7 people. After the group returns from the EU universities and prepares the necessary teaching materials in the local language based on the knowledge gained there, we plan to increase the number of master students on this specialty. In the future, we also plan to open a master's course at our in Karshi branch, which will naturally increase the number of masters.

As for the laboratory "Computer Systems in Medicine", I inform you that research is already being intensively conducted not only by the staff of the TUIT department, but also joint projects are being prepared with some Tashkent medical universities on technical rehabilitation, which will increase the efficiency of the laboratory and results of the project too.

I take this opportunity to once again express my respect and readiness for further cooperation with you and your University.
